Everyone is welcome to attend.

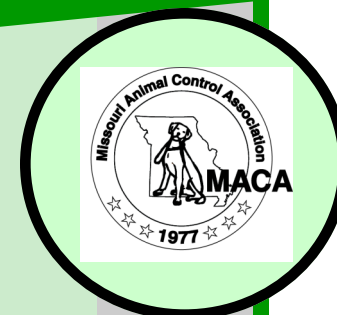
Registration Deadline: Registrations must be received by September 10, 2009. Walk-in registration will be allowed at an additional \$25.00 per person.
